Employment-Based Reform Initiatives

- Revocation of Buy American-Hire American Doctrine
 - BAHA
 - EO released April 2017
 - A harbinger of things to come
 - EO rescinding BAHA January 2021
 - Sets a more open, inclusive tone
 - Possible decrease in denials and RFEs?



Revisions to the H-1B Program

- Definition of Specialty Occupation
 - Proposed changes under previous administration
 - Current standing of proposed changes
 - Current adjudication practices
 - Rescission of 2017 memo that suggests computer programmers cannot constitute a specialty occupation
 - Suggests change in attitude towards IT professionals



Revisions to the H-1B Program

- H-1B Wage Considerations
 - Employers must pay the required wage
 - Greater of the prevailing wage or actual wage paid to similarly situated employees
 - Calculating the prevailing wage and wage levels
 - Proposed rule and delayed effective date
 - Would impact H-1Bs and permanent residency process through PERM labor certification



H-1B Lottery Registration

- 85,000 H-1Bs available per fiscal year (October 1 -September 30)
- Lottery to determine who is selected for coveted slots
- Employer registration selection process same as last year
- Proposed changes to the lottery and delayed effective date

Miscellaneous EB Updates

- Status of the Public Charge Rule
 - On again and off again...and on again and off again
- F/J Reforms
 - Not moving forward
- H-4 Employment Authorization
 - Rule to rescind withdrawn

International Travel Restrictions and Visa Bans

- Travel Restrictions
 - Schengen Area, UK, Ireland, Brazil, South Africa
- Essential travel restrictions
- Visa Suspensions
 - H, L, J
- Consular processing
 - Emergency, Expedited, Closures

International Travel Restrictions and Visa Bans

- National Interest Exceptions
 - H-1B (public health, government, ongoing employment, economy)
 - H-2B (government, economy)
 - J-1 (care, public charge, childcare, exchange)
 - L-1A (public health, government, ongoing employment, senior manager)
 - L-1B (public health, government, ongoing employment, critical infrastructure)

- International Student Exemption
- Quarantine and negative test requirements

- Abolishing per country quotas
- Recapturing unused immigrant visas

- Time requirements for issuing interim benefits
- Eliminating biometrics for H dependents
